The Summer Food Program was in operation starting May 25th through July 15th. With 3 school sites open to the public and meals transported to six apartment complexes and one church, the Child Nutrition Department served 47,194 meals to kids. The program is free to any person 18 or younger, and no registration or identification is required. "OneMore, ServeMore" was the slogan for this year's meal program, and MSDWT met that goal by adding a new serving location at an apartment complex. We already have an additional site for next summer at Riverwood Park, 7201 Crittenden Ave. (previously White River School).
