Cold Weather Safety Tips from Officer Lindsey

1. Always dress in layers.

3. Be aware of the signs of "frostbite", such as pale, grey or blistered skin on the fingers, nose, ears and toes. If a person shows these signs or symptoms immediately call 911, then bring them indoors and warm the effected area(s) slowly.
