## Guidelines From Stakeholder Feedback for the Open Dialog

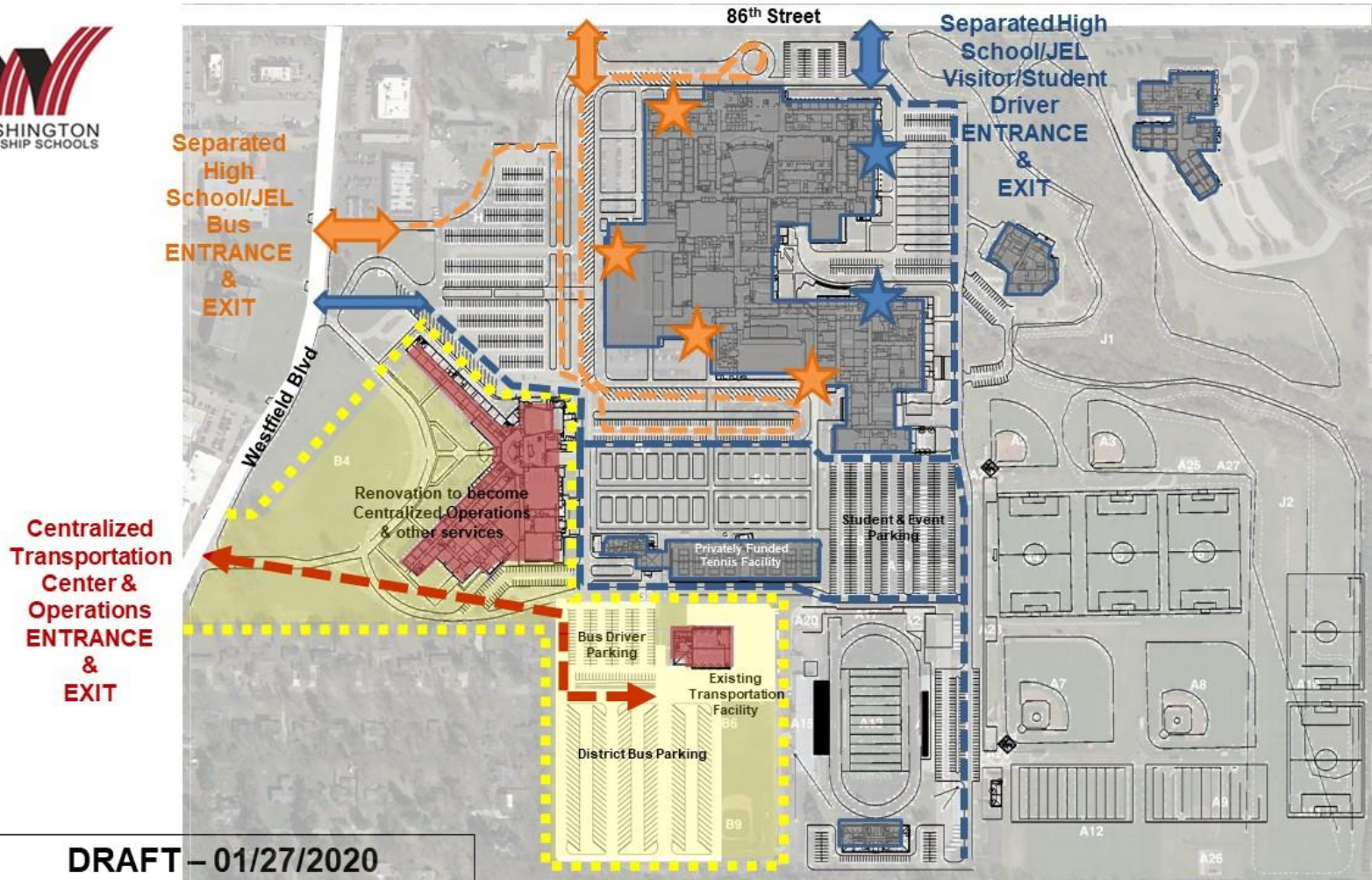
1. Wear name tag
