Services are paid through Medicaid, private insurance, other third party sources, or on a sliding scale, which is paid for by the family.

Our Life Skills Specialists are Bachelor level providers that are placed in each school providing services to help students and their families with learning various skills to manage the above referenced challenges. This service can take place once the initial intake assessment has been completed and can be paid through Medicaid or self-pay.
