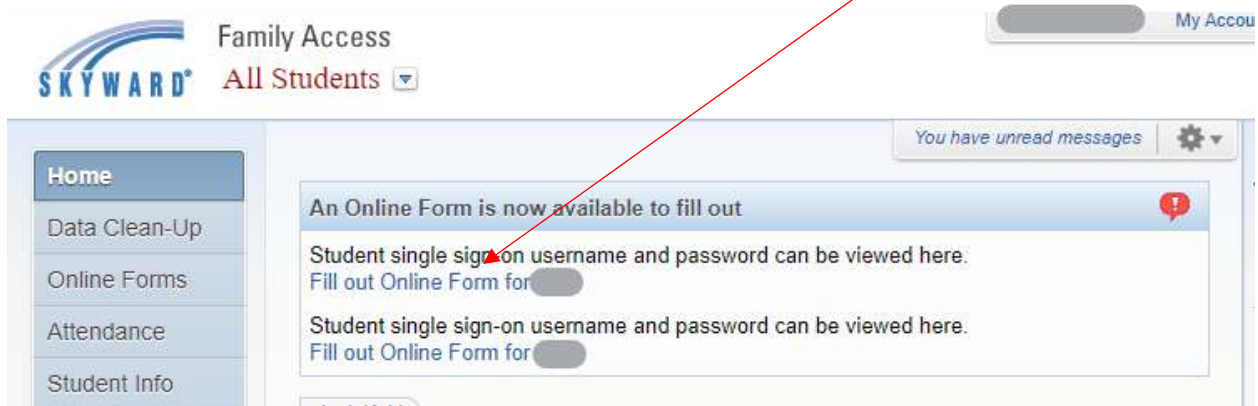
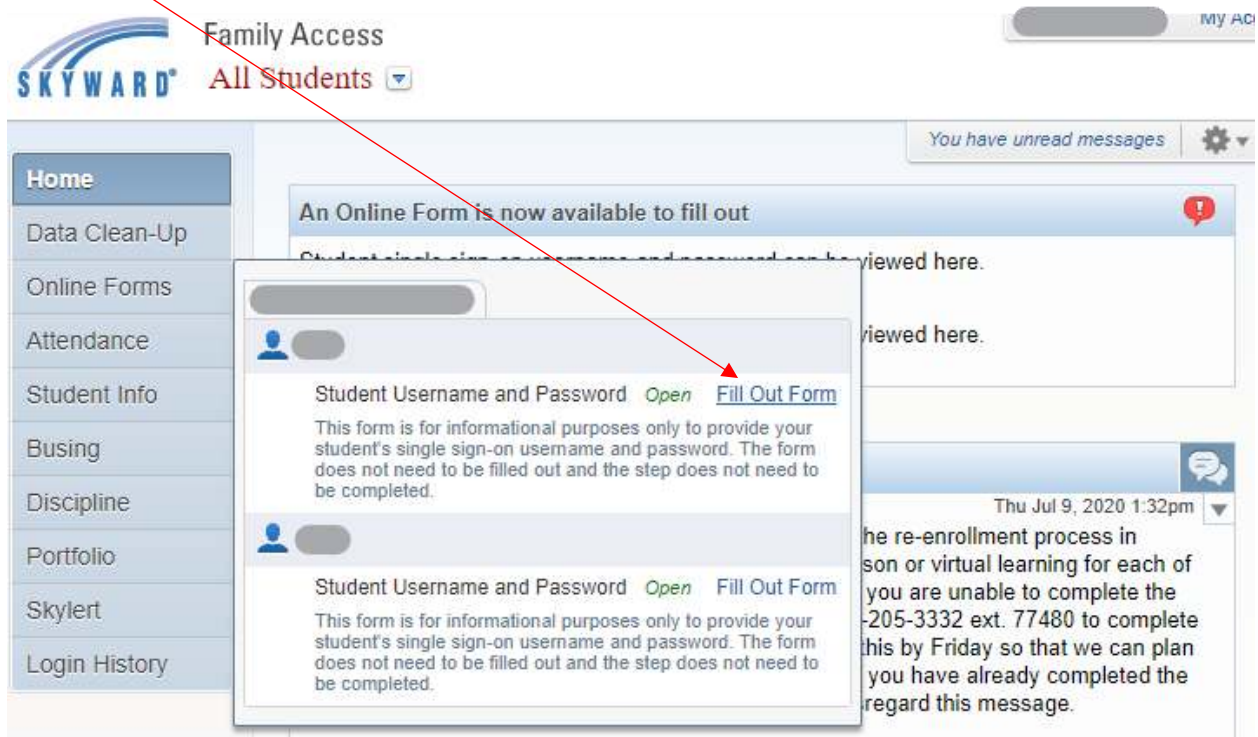


Viewing student usernames and passwords in Skyward Family Access

After logging in to Skyward Family Access you will see a link to Fill out Online Form for *your student*. You can click on the link to view that student's username and password.



You can also click on the Online Forms tab on the left which will pop up a window and you can click the Fill Out Form link to view the student's username and password.



Although this is a form, it is for informational purposes only and does not need to be filled out and the steps do not need to be completed. At the District Message screen click the Student Username and Password link on the right
