**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE METROPOLITAN  
SCHOOL DISTRICT OF WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP, MARION COUNTY,  
INDIANA, FOR COVID-19 IMPLICATIONS**

WHEREAS, the United States of America and the State of Indiana have faced a pandemic caused by the coronavirus and COVID-19;

WHEREAS, the District continues to closely monitor the spread of COVID-19 in Indiana with updates from international, federal, state, and local governmental agencies; and

WHEREAS, the safety of students and their families and employees of the District remains a central concern to the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE METROPOLITAN SCHOOL DISTRICT OF WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP, MARION COUNTY, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

Effective May 31, 2021 the current Washington Township Schools COVID-19 Operations Plan will terminate.

Effective June 1, 2021 Washington Township Schools will abide by the Marion County Public Health Department and Indiana State Department of Health COVID-19 guidance for schools.

**Resolution authority:**


- a. District Administration is delegated the full power and authority by this Board of Education to implement and carry out the provisions of the foregoing and any and all district policies and regulations or other District documents inconsistent with the foregoing which would otherwise prevent, hinder, or delay necessary action in carrying out or implementing the same in order to respond to the pandemic are hereby waived and suspended as allowed by law;
- b. In exercising the above authority, the Superintendent or designee will keep members of the Board of Education reasonably informed of actions taken pursuant to the foregoing authority; and
- c. This resolution supersedes prior resolutions on this matter.

THIS RESOLUTION adopted this 12th day of May, 2021 by at least a majority vote of the entire Board in a public meeting.
